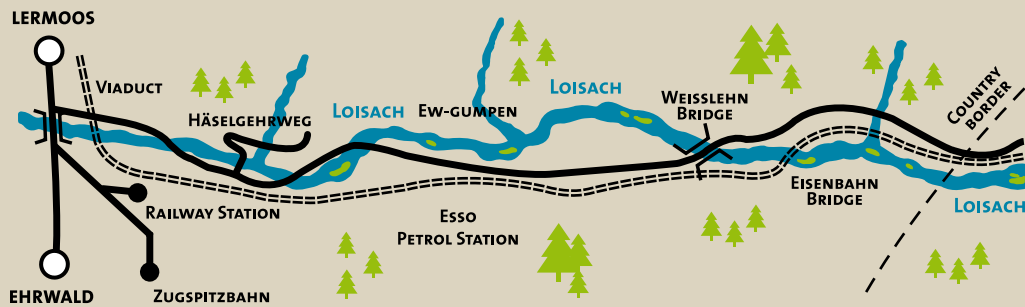

 Season from beginning of May - October

### **The Loisach – an Eldorado for the Passionate Fly Fisher**

**Body of Water:** 15 km/9 mi. of private fly fishing area from the source to the country border, of which 10 km/6 mi. are open for fishing. Very low susceptibility to climatic conditions. The width of the water varies between 8 to 20 m (24 – 60 ft), easy to wade and located in spectacular, wooded mountain scenery. Varying fast and slow stretches, weirs, basins and bends.

**Estuary:** From the viaduct in Ehrwald to the border with Bavaria. Partially following the road between Ehrwald and Garmisch, partially away from the road in quiet wooded areas (easily accessible from the nearby cycle path).

**The Fish Stock:** Brown trout and rainbow trout. Occasionally char and graylings.

**The Guidelines:** Only fly rods with a maximum of 2 artificial flies (wet or dry) on a leader. BARBLESS HOOKS ARE OBLIGATORY!

**CATCH & RELEASE!** This means that the fish you catch must be released as carefully as possible. Should you wish to eat one of the fish you caught, you are welcome to bring it along and have our cook prepare it for you.

**What is prohibited?** Live or dead bait, such as worms, maggots, grasshoppers, as well as spinners, devons, paternosters, and clear bubble floats are prohibited. BARBED HOOKS ARE NOT ALLOWED!

### **The Blindsee (private lake)**

**Body of Water:** Deep, clear mountain lake (aprox. 55 acres) at 1,093 m (3,600 ft) above sea level on the Fernpass. Ideal for fly fishing, spinning and trolling.

**The Fish Stock:** Good stock of brown, rainbow and lake trout, as well as whitefish, lake char and pike-perch.

**The Guidelines:** Only handheld rods (casting, trolling or fly-rod), as well as artificial flies, spinners, Stellfisch rods, dead fish bait or trolling systems are permissible. WITH BARBLESS HOOKS ONLY!

**What is prohibited?** All other live or natural bait such as worms, maggots, etc. are prohibited. BARBED HOOKS ARE NOT PERMITTED!

**The Service:** Access to the car park by the lake.

### **The Mittersee (private lake)**

**Body of Water:** Quiet, warm lake in the woods (approx. 20 acres) with a natural beach for swimming. ONLY ACCESSIBLE BY FOOT! (Closed forest road).

**The Fish Stock:** Very good stock of wild carp and mirror carp, pike, tench, roach.

**The Guidelines:** Only a maximum of three hand rods (casting rods or pole rigged rods), however, only one rod for predatory fish) are permitted. Spinners, dead fish bait, pota toes, dough, bread are allowed.

WITH BARBLESS HOOKS ONLY!

**What is prohibited?** All other live or natural baits such as worms, maggots etc. are prohibited. BARBED HOOKS ARE NOT PERMITTED!

### **The Weissensee (private lake)**

#### **Protected area**

**The Area:** The Weissensee, as well as the Loisach from the source to the Ehrwald viaduct, including all tributaries in the moor, are nurseries for fish species and there fore

CLOSED TO SPORT FISHING!

#### **Guest Fishing Licenses**

Are only issued to guests of the Mohr Life Resort. The holder must carry the license with him at all times and show it to the authorities (guards, police, customs, etc.) on request. The loss of any guest fishing license will be charged to the amount of EUR 220.00. No refund will be given for unused fishing days and licenses or guest licenses are not transferable. Fishing is undertaken at the exclusive risk of the fisher. Damage to forest cultures and facilities must be avoided (personal liability). By signing the license, the guest agrees to all applicable regulations.
